CEDAR HOUSE, MAIN ROAD, HALLOW. Grid Ref: SO8276 5808



Cedar House is within the Conservation Area and sits on a substantial plot sideways to the main road and opposite Hallow Green.

It is a substantial Victorian villa constructed of brick with slate roofing tiles and retaining many original features. The majority of the garden, with several mature trees, is to the front of the property, which is approached by a long drive. The earliest date recorded for the property is 1867 when Cedar House was left by owner John Forty to his wife.



To the rear of the property and bordering the main road are 3 semi-detached, brick built cottages – Cedar Cottages. Research has shown that rent was paid by the tenants of some of these cottage to owners of Cedar House.
